Traveling across Canada as a live painter, Jessica was inspired to start a series of Youtube videos titled Art In Motion, bringing the energy of the stage out onto the street. Her videos follow her painting a live portrait through cosmopolitan streets, making art on the beach, dancing through the aisles of a moving plane and over seventy more scenarios have gone viral. One of Jessica's most memorable experiences as a painter happened in the fall of 2011 when she was selected by Cirque Du Soleil to entertain special guests before the critically acclaimed show "Totem." As a result, Jessica put on 77 unforgettable shows in the Tapis Rouge VIP tent for crowds of up to 350 people.

Her shows quickly created a buzz, especially among the many tourists who attended the Cirque performance each day. Her time at Cirque was immensely successful and Jess continues to use this "light canvas" in her performances across the country.

Jessica's experiences and extensive travels have guided her through each journey, making this 31-year-old Canadian a force of nature in the art industry. Her last exhibit, "Paint My Candy" exhibited 45 of her original acrylic and oil paintings on

a variety of canvases in a 15,000-square-foot space. The [pièce de résistance](#) of the night was a four-foot canvas portraying a woman's face with 3500 coloured pieces of candy. More than 1,000 people attended the show.

Some other opportunities and highlights from 2011 are: Coca-Cola, L'Oreal Fashion Week 2011, Norman Felix Gallery, Lululemon, Nuit Blanche, Soho Gallery Montreal, CP24's live federal election show, City TV's Breakfast Television and Sotheby's Art Auction.

The next large exhibit is March 29th, 2012 at House of Moments Gallery, 388 Carlaw, Toronto, Ont. Followed by a stop in Vancouver for a group exhibit on May 4th, 2012. Jessica then travels to Montreal for a solo exhibit on May 17th, 2012 and comes back to Toronto for a solo summer show at Twist Gallery in June 2012.

Her own gallery and studio space, aptly named Jessgo, in the north of Toronto, and mid town Toronto at 945 Wilson Avenue showcases her latest works on floor to ceiling canvases. Her latest collection of candy/cirque paintings and vibrant portraits reflect a new stage in Gorlicky's career — one graced with spirited energy and confidence. Individuality is important to Gorlicky who never fails to capture the freedom and expression of it in each of her pieces.
